1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the Institution:

Various activities under taken by the college during the year 2006-2007 amply reflect the goals and objectives set by the college.

- a) New course of computer Knowledge and Application at FYBA level has been started from June 2006.
 - b) New course of MS- CIT conducted by MKCL has been started in our college.
 - c) Examination reform implemented with academic guardianship.
 - d) NSS wing of the college is trying to action the objectives satisfactorily through community service.
 - e) Office Automation, Computerization of Library provided under technology up gradation.
 - f) Financial aids are provided to the students from weaker section of society through various schemes.
 - g) For personality development and awareness of competitive among examinations students career guidance cell has organized series of lectures through out the academic year.
 - h) Faculty members of this institution are deciphering the knowledge to the various institutions by delivering extension lectures as resource persons and writing articles in the daily newspapers.
 - i) **Vivekvahini and Yuvatisabha** : for overall development of the students the college has established Vivekvahini and Yuvatisabha as platforms under the co- coordinator ship of Prof. C. S.Karanke. Vivekvahini and Yuvatisabha organized debate on various topics such as personality development, AIDS awareness, problems of dowry and marriage, de-addiction and proper food and need of exercise etc. They also organized essay competition, elocution competition, poem reciting etc. All these programmes were held on every week. Finally, prize distribution held on 17feb,2007.
 - j) **Campus Beautification** : Due emphasis has given on the campus beautification. Proper care was taken of various flowery plants and other trees. During the year 2006-07 some teak and Almond plants have been planted on 7 Aug,2006. Near about 50 Almond plants are gifted to H.R. Patel mahavidyala , Shirpur. Classrooms and varandas are decorated by the green flowery plants and creepers.
 - k) **Language forum** : During the year 2006-07 language forum established under the co- ordinatorship of Prof. Y.R. Patil and three lectures were arranged on various topics. Prof. Makrani delivered a lecture on ‘ Sheroshayri ’dated, 18 Sept,2006. Prof. Pardeshi delivered a lecture on ‘Gazal’ in his Inauguratory speech.
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On 16th Oct,206. Prof. C.S.Karanke expressed his view on ‘ Loksahhitya ek Aanubhav ’ on 18 Dec, 2006 poems were recited by the students. Students actively took part in it.

- l) **Book Bank scheme** : The Book Bank scheme has been established in our library. Through this facility the college provide books to poor and needy students. Near about 12 students got benefit from it. The sanstha's has started ‘Sarvajanik vachanalaya’ for other citizens in the village.
- m) **Employment counseling centre** : It conducts lectures and competitive examination for the improvement of General Knowledge. The center provided application forms to the students for various jobs.
- n) **Educational Trips** : As trips are the part and parcel of Knowledge and information, the college have organized one day department wise trips at various places are as follows.
