

ANNEXURE-VI

An University level workshop on 'soil and water conservation'

An University level workshop on 'Soil and water conservation' was held on 05th Feb.2008. This one day workshop was organized by department of Geography, Arts College Bamkhede T.T. and sponsored by North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. Near about 45 participants were present for the workshop. Following is the brief report of proceeding of this University level workshop.

The whole workshop divided into four sessions . In the morning at 9.30 a.m. Prof.M.V.Baride, Registrar, North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon inaugurated the workshop .He delivered the keynote address on 'Present Water Scenario in India '. He said water and soil plays key role in advancing civilizations and have great socio- Economic values .He also gave emphasis on the need for proper planning and management of water and soil .He appealed to educationalist , Researchers and Scientist to discuss such importance issues .

In the very next session Prof.Dadasaheb Bhatewal, Chairman Board of studies in Geography, N.M.U.Jalgaon shared his view on water supply sources, ground water,storage of water demands in various sector like Irrigation ,Hydropower, Domestic industry etc. He stressed on various other benefits like flood control, drought mitigation, fish culture ,navigation and recreation, water quality management, and employement generation gives indirect benefits. He presented the future consequences of water if we continue to be careless regarding water management.

A well known social worker and a true Nature lover Mr.Haidarbhai Nurani delivered his lecturer on 'Proper use of Water and Tree Plantation'.By giving very practical examples he made his speech very effective and lively .He said that we should be very careful while using water in our day today life. It is every individuals responsibility to plant and protect at least one tree. The plants like 'Basil 'Banyan Tree ' etc. should be planted as these trees gives oxygen both at day and night. In the afternoon session which was full of practical demonstration Mr.Suresh Khanapurkar, A Renowned senior Geologist put the facts of over exploitation of ground water, progressive water level decline, water quality problems in areas like Vidharbha and Khandesh. To over come these problems he provided a perfect solution which he him self experimented in the area near by Shirpur. He said that sinking of deep well is essential to percolate rain water. Besides this water ter tight are also useful to increase the underground water level . Small weirs need to construct so that we could yield adequate food grains and vegetables.

Principal S.R.Chaudhari, Pratap College Amalner gave emphasis on 'River Linkage Project' . He explained the possibility of diverting water of Ganga river in to draught affected areas. And, this water need to be stored in the unsaturated zone . By doing this thousands of Acres land can be brought under irrigation. To succeed in this attempt, he said it need thorough plan and some heavy fund.

Dr.G.N.Dange ,Chief Centre for Agricultural Science , Kolada ,Dist-Nandurbar . He gave a lecture on 'Organic farming' .He expressed concerned over soil pollution and its quality degradation which further causes in reducing fertility competence. As a result it directly affects on productivity and production of commodity. He expressed need of making awareness about the farmers through such discussion and suggestion .He also explained the details of hydrofracturing for artificial recharging.

The concluding session ended with participants interaction for an hour .Most of the participants expressed their views that , such workshop should be extended for three to four days and periodically organized .Participants and resource persons unanimously expressed their feelings about introduction of a separate subjects about study of soil and water conservation at School and College level.
