SECTION: 1

Academic Programmes:

a) Construction of ladies hostel:

A proposal to this is ready sent to UGC and it is expected to be sanctioned. The college plans to go for the construction of ladies hostel during 2010- 2011.

b) Development of library:

A proposal to this is ready to send to UGC to receive the grant to enrich collection of books and to make it quality oriented. The college is expected to receive the grant from UGC during the year 2009-10. Audio cassettes player facility will be provided on priority basis. It is also decided to send a proposal to UGC for the financial assistance to construct Library Building.

c) Technology Up gradation:

In continuation of its drive towards the use of technology for imposing the quality at all levels college plans to provide the latest computers with all necessary equipments such as LCD projectors, printers, digital camera, photocopier etc.

d) Media facility:

Necessary equipment like scanner, digital camera, and microphone would be provided to IQAC for creation of media facility for the development of audio / video learning materials.

e) Infrastructure:

- i) A proposal for ladies hostel will be submitted to UGC.
- ii) A proposal for separate library building will be submitted to UGC.
- iii) A Separate Gymnasium Building will be constructed.
- iv) Advanced and necessary equipment will be purchased in the Gymnasium.
- v) A separate Ladies Room will be constructed.
- vi) A Common Room will be constructed.
- vii) A proposal for Seminar Hall will be submitted to UGC.

f) Medical Checkup of students and staff:

Medical checkup programme is arranged every year in the first term it is conducted by the college with the help of medical officer. It will be continued in the academic year 2009-10. Blood donation camp will also be organized.

g) Meeting with parents and Alumni:

Meeting with parents Alumni will be organized during the year 2009-10 to collect new ideas from them to undertake development programmes in the College.

1. New Courses:

- a) The college has decided to start M.A. in Hindi on Non grant Basis. The proposal was designed and submitted to N.M.U. Jalgaon and Govt. of Maharashtra for approval.
- b) The College has decided to start career oriented course like Functional English in the college.
- c) The college has also decided to start short term course such as screen printing, carpeting, book binding, courses related to cooking, embroidery, tailoring, beauty parlor etc. to be introduced after getting permission from the affiliating University.

2. Academic Calendar: A Detailed academic calendar for 2009–2010 along with Academic diary has been finalized for its distribution to faculty. Academic Calendar entails all important events such as examination and academic schedule for 2009–2010.

3. Faculty Improvement Programme: The College is eligible to provide this facility. This would be adding to the research credit of the institution. Research facilities will be provided to the teachers joining under FIP.

4. Seminars/workshop:

a) College intends to conduct 2 day state and National level seminar in the subjects Hindi and English respectively. It has been also decided to conduct state level seminar in Library Science.

5. Extension lectures: Guest lectures by eminent and subject experts in all departments will be arranged for the UG and PG Students.

6. Research Project: Teachers will be encouraged to submit minor/major research project. It has been also decided to promote the teachers to publish their books, articles and research papers in reputed journals. The teachers will be encouraged to go for their Ph.Ds.

7. Career Guidance Activities: In collaboration with Maharashtra Center for Entrepreneurship Development, lectures will be arranged for the students. The successful personalities will be invited to share their experiences with the students to make their career in the administrative field, to set up a separate full-fledged library, having quality and good number of books, to organize General Knowledge Tests and Quizzes, to promote the students to prepare for the various competitive exams.

8. Internet connectivity to Departments: Every department will be provided Internet connectivity. Internet facility will be provided to staff and students.

9. NSS:

- h) District level leadership development programme will be undertaken for volunteers of college from Nandurbar district.
- i) Peer educators training for youths will be organized in collaboration with Regional NSS Center.
- j) A programme on scientific explanation of miracles, drug abuse and personality development will be organized.
